NEW YORK – The donation drive spearheaded by FilComm leaders of New York, New Jersey and Pennsylvania in cooperation with the Philippine Consulate General New York, continues.

Dubbed “**Project Tulong**”, the drive will accept donations of any amount, starting from \$1.00. Cash donations are accepted at drop-boxes at the Philippine Center, c/o PROJECT TULONG.

The drive will continue until the end of September. Donations will then be sent to the most affected areas of the typhoon, as stated by the National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC). The Philippine Consulate General and the Filipino-American community of Northeast USA have enjoined one and all to be generous in sharing whatever they can donate for the typhoon victims.
