

RECEIVE YOUR DOCUMENTS BY MAIL

All applicants for Philippine passport, visa and legal documents (e.g. Reports of Birth/Marriage/Death, Affidavit, Special Power of Attorney, Certification, etc.) who cannot personally come back to the Consulate General to claim their processed documents have the option to receive their documents by mail.

Applicants are requested to submit a self-addressed stamped return envelope (preferably certified mail or priority mail) for their processed documents. (Envelopes with metered stamps will not be accepted.)

The Consulate General will mail the return envelopes containing the applicants' documents, but it will not be responsible for any delay or loss of documents during the transit of these documents.
